

# Vocab. Bellringer



1. Decide what the most important key term is in your lesson tomorrow (hint- it's probably a vocab. word).
2. Write that word on your board.
3. When your students come in have them take out a sheet of notebook paper, write down the word, find it in the book, and write 2 facts about it.
4. When they're done writing their facts, call on a few to share one of their facts. Use that opportunity to start small discussions and ask them questions to see how well they understand the concept.
